Qualifications for Officers

- 1. You must set a good example for all orchestra students through musicianship, practice habits, general attitude, and cooperation.
- 2. You MUST have a school discipline record in good standing. You should have no prior record of excessive tardies and no suspensions.
- 3. You must have and maintain passing grades in **all** classes.
- 4. You must be able to fulfill the requirements of the position per the Directors' discretion.
